

William F. Penwell, PhD. is currently a professor of biology at Jacksonville University. He authors the "Fecal Indicator Bacteria" section of the *2022 State of the St. Johns River Report*.

Dr. Penwell's research interests focus on three major areas: 1) virulence factors used by the human pathogen, Acinetobacter baumannii, 2) antibiotic discovery from
